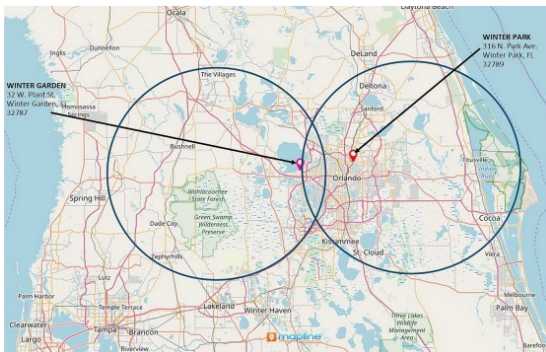
NEIGHBORHOOD: WINTER PARK
